Terms of Consignment

Welcome! We are pleased that you have decided to consign your item(s) with us at Next Time Around. Here's how it works:

When you bring your items in, we will select what we think our customers will buy. We may decline some of your items. Please don't take this personally as we consider many variables in determining what we can accept. Declined items can either be returned or donated/disposed.

Items you wish to have returned must be picked up within 3 business days of us calling you. If you don't pick up your items within the 3 days, we will assume you are allowing us to donate or dispose of the items on your behalf. We do not accept items that we cannot sell for a minimum of \$10.00.

We display your items for 80 days and you receive 40% of the selling price. A small buyer fee is added to every item. This fee is paid by the buyer and is reflected in our price tags. We collect and submit sales tax on your behalf.

The selling price will be reduced periodically:

- After 20 days - a 15% reduction of original price
- After 40 days - a further 10% reduction
- After 60 days - a final 10% reduction

Please note: Seasonal décor will be discounted at our leisure and may not be displayed for a full 80 days.

We may make further reductions at our discretion and/or have occasional sales in order to help facilitate sales. It is in our best interest to sell your items for the best possible price, but should an offer come in towards the end of the contract period, we need to know what your lowest acceptable price is.

We have many friends who consign with us therefore it is up to the consignor to track dates and pick up unsold items following the contract period. If you do not pick up your items by day 90, they become the property of Next Time Around and will be disposed of, sold at a reduced amount, or donated to a local charity. X _____

If you wish to reclaim items before the contract period ends, you may do so, but there will be a holdback charge of 10% of the starting price.

Cheques over \$20.00 can be picked up at the store on or after the 10th on the month following the month the item is sold. Unclaimed, lost, or stale-dated cheques will not be re-issued. We do not call you to tell you your cheque is ready.

The consignor warrants that the items were not obtained illegally. X _____

We are not an antique shop and do not make any claims to knowing the market value of your piece. We price our items on what we think our buyers will pay. If you have antiques, it is best to have them appraised by an experienced dealer.

All décor items (accessories, lights, pictures, dishes, small items, etc.) that you wish to consign must be dropped off in a box or container labelled with your name and phone number along with a detailed itemized list. Please give us as much information as you can for your item(s) such as description, price you paid, where you bought it and the lowest amount you will accept for the item (optional).

Please understand that this is a public place where customers are able to handle your items. We will do our best to safeguard them, however accidents and theft can happen. We are not responsible for theft, breakage or any other damages to your items. X _____
